



**SCOTTISH CARP GROUP:**  
**PHASE 3: COVID-19 TEMPORARY RULES**  
**UPDATED: 19<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2020**



**ALL SCG MEMBERS**

1. **ALL PERSONS FISHING WILL BE REQUIRED TO ALSO FOLLOW GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES:**

2. All SCG waters are currently open.
  - a. **ALL** waters are subject to landowner / leaseholder permissions and may change at any time.
3. If you are feeling ill or suffering from covid-19 or anyone in your household is suffering from symptoms **DO NOT TRAVEL** to the fishery.
4. Under 16s may accompany an adult member from same household.
5. All anglers **MUST** bring sanitiser for own personal use, paying particular care when opening and closing gates (advise sanitising before / after use).
6. Social distancing (2m minimum) **MUST** be adhered to according to government guidelines, and **DO NOT ENTER** anyone else's swim unless there is an emergency.
  - a. No tackle, rod pods etc to be left on public paths (Lanark especially).
  - b. Bivvies must be 10m apart or designated swims.
7. **MAXIMUM TIME** allowed on any SCG water restricted to 72hours
  - a. **NO** return within 24 hours.
8. **NO** sharing of food, water, bait or any equipment including landing nets and cameras.
9. Anglers **MUST** have a portable toilet / bucket & bag if fishing overnight. **REMOVE ALL** rubbish & waste from site on leaving.
  - a. Further, no spitting or urinating in swims.
10. Anglers **MUST** follow venue specific rules and signage:
11. Anglers **MUST** be in possession of valid SCG membership card at all times. If asked to show card by bailiff, place on ground and retreat 2m to allow safe inspection.
12. **ANY MEMBER NOT ADHERING TO THESE RULES WILL HAVE THEIR MEMBERSHIP REVOKED.**
